



A recent investigation by scientists at the U.S. Geological Survey shows that strange animal behavior might hel predict future earthquakes. Investigators found such occurrences in a ten-kilometer radius of the epicenter of fairly recent quake. Some birds screeched and flew about wildly; dogs yelped and ran around uncontrollably Scientists believe that animals can perceive these environmental changes as early as several days before the mishap In 1976 after observing animal behavior, the Chinese were able to predict a devastating quake. Although hundred of thousands of people were killed, the government was able to evacuate millions of other people and thus keep th death toll at a lower level.
